Spending by Household Size, 2013

Spending tends to increase with household size because larger households usually have more earners. Households with four or more people spent the most in 2013, an average of more than \$65,000 and 27 to 34 percent more than the average household. Only 23 percent of the nation's households are home to four or more people, however.

Two-person households are most common. They account for 32 percent of all households. Two-person households spent an average of \$54,568 in 2013, 7 percent more than the average household. Households with two people (many of them empty-nesters) spend considerably more than other households on food prepared by consumer unit on trips, other lodging (primarily hotel and motel expenses on trips), and alcoholic beverages among other categories.

Single-person households are almost as numerous as two-person households and accounted for 30 percent of the total in 2013. Single-person households spend well less than the average household on every item except rent.
